The Society proposes to hold the following information for every Member:- their name, address, telephone no(s) – landline, mobile and email address (where this exists). The above information will be held by the Chairman, Mrs Caroline Peel (who, technically, is known as the 'Data Controller').

As a safeguard against a computer failure, a security copy of the data is held by the Treasurer (Joanna Truman) who is the 'Deputy Data Controller'. This information is held on a computer database which is password protected with the password only being known by these two people. This data is archived, in a secure form, each year.

The data will only be used for the purpose of producing a record of Members and Membership Fees paid and for the Chairman, Secretary & Membership Secretary to send out email notices (including details of any cancellations or changes to meetings etc.) and letters/emails to Members. This data will be updated, as necessary, and checked annually.

MOST IMPORTANTLY, the data will not be supplied to anybody else (except where we are required to do so by law). Members, by signing this 'Opt in' agree to do the same.

Those who have 'Opted in' have the following rights in respect of the data held by the Chairman:-

- to ask the Chairman, as the 'Data Controller', to provide a copy of the data held relating to themselves
- to have this data updated, altered or deleted and to restrict the use that is made of it within the limits already set out above
